XI. ORDINANCE, FINAL READING

6. An ordinance authorizing the sale of two retired (reserve) Fire Department 1984 Sutphen Deluge pumper trucks to the Eastwood Volunteer Fire Department, for the sum of \$2,800.00 each at no interest over a period of seven (7) years. (Sponsored by Councilmen Reed, Rockhold, and Lynch)

7. An ordinance zoning recently annexed property, commonly known as lots 158, 159, 160, 161, and 162 (parcels 132, 131, 130, 129, and 128); and a portion of Grandview Street, as R-4 zoning. (Sponsored by the Municipal Planning Commission.)

8. An ordinance suspending the operation of the longevity plan, Section VIII, the Compensation Plan, of the City of Parkersburg Personnel Policies and Procedures, and said suspension shall continue until further action of City Council. (Sponsored by Councilmen Wilcox, Lynch, Rockhold and Reed)

9. An ordinance amending and re-enacting the Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual to reflect twenty seven (27) reclassifications. (Sponsored by the Personnel Committee of City Council.)

An ordinance granting a base pay increase to regular full-time and appointed part-time employees of the City of Parkersburg. \$2.00 per hour to base pay in the Police Department; \$1.00 per hour to base pay in the Fire Department; and \$0.70 per hour to base pay for all other regular full time employees and appointed part-time employees.
