7. Transferring ownership of real estate, being a parking lot at 1<sup>st</sup> and Juliana Streets, to the Urban Renewal Authority, and exchanging this property for the structure at 113 Ann Street. (Finance Committee of City Council)
8. Establishing parking rates for a new short-term parking lot at Third Street and Phillips Court Alley at \$1.00 per hour. (Finance Committee)
