1. Resolution authorizing Police Chief, Joseph Martin, to sign and enter into an agreement with the Wood County Drug and Related Crimes Task Force which includes the City of Vienna, and the County of Wood. (Sponsored by all members of City Council)

2. Resolution requesting approval from the State Tax Commissioner for a budget revision in the amount of \$30,000.00 out of the Capital Reserve Fund, related to the above-mentioned Wood County Drug and Related Crimes Task Force. (Sponsored by all members of City Council)

3. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert Newell to enter into a contractual agreement with the Division of Justice and Community Services to receive and administer grant funds in the amount of \$20,000.00 for one (1) PRO officer at Parkersburg High School. (Sponsored by all members of City Council)

4. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert Newell to enter into a contractual agreement with the U. S. Department of Justice to receive and administer a COPS (Community Oriented Policing Services) grant in the amount of \$343,940.00 for three PRO officers in our middle schools. (Sponsored by all members of City Council)

5. Resolution authorizing a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of Parkersburg and the West Virginia Intelligence/Fusion Center, pertaining to the application of automatic license plate readers. (Sponsored by Councilmen Reed, Kelly, and Rockhold)

6. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert Newell to sign the Emergency Shelter Grant contract in the amount of \$14,500.00, the objective being that priorities are given to activities to meet the needs for homeless persons. (Sponsored by Councilmen Reed, Rockhold, and Lynch)

7. Resolution requesting a budget revision within the CDBG budget moving \$8,000.00 from 2012 Code Enforcement line item, to 2013 line item for 13<sup>th</sup> Street sidewalk. (Sponsored by Councilmen Reed, Rockhold, and Lynch.)
