SUPPLEMENTARY CONDITIONS

- 1. The person, firm or corporation to whom a permit is issued agrees to hold the City of Parkersburg harmless on account of any damages to persons or property which may arise during the progress of the work authorized by this permit or by reason thereof.
2. Applications for permission to perform work within street rights of way shall be made on CITY'S standard permit form and shall be signed by the authorized representative of the person, firm or corporation applying.
3. The application shall give full information concerning the work to be done and shall be accompanied by a sketch sufficient to show the nature and location of the work to be performed if required by engineer.
4. APPLICANT, his agents, successor, heirs or assigns, contractors or any other person, firm or corporation working under APPLICANT'S real or apparent authority, shall perform the work in a manner satisfactory to CITY. Damage to the road resulting at any time from work authorized under this permit shall be repaired by APPLICANT. Unsatisfactory repairs may be corrected by CITY or its authorized agent and the cost hereof paid by APPLICANT.
5. CITY assumes no liability for damage to the proposed work by reason of construction or maintenance work on the street.
6. This permit is granted subject to removal of the authorized installation by APPLICANT at no cost to CITY when required for improvement of the street and subject to all regulations now or hereafter adopted by CITY.
7. Repairs necessitated by utility installation shall be in accordance with the current CITY'S standards and specifications for pavement, sidewalk, and curb repair.
8. Driveways shall be repaired to condition existing prior to issuance of permit.
9. CITY reserves the right to cancel this permit at any time, should APPLICANT fail to comply with the terms and conditions under which it is granted.
10. This permit is granted only insofar as the CITY has the right to do so.
