 1. Resolution re-appointing Mr. Steve Mohwish, 3300 ½ Camden Avenue, and Mr. Joe Gonzales, 8 Greenview Drive, to the Wood County Recreation Commission for terms to expire January 26, 2013. (Councilmen Tallman, Joyce, Sandy, and Lynch)
 2. Resolution re-appointing Mr. William Morrison, 1902 43rd Street, to the Board of Zoning Appeals for a term to expire January 1, 2013. (Councilmen Tallman, Sandy, Kimes, and Lynch.)

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4. Resolution authorizing the Finance Director to expend funds from the Capital Reserve Fund for the Fire Department efficiency and effectiveness study in the amount of \$12,650.00. (Councilmen Kimes, Reed, and Joyce)
 5. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert D. Newell and Police Chief Joseph Martin to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Parkersburg Police Department and the United States Marshals Service for Fiscal year 2010. The City was asked to participate in this local Task Force whose purpose is to locate and apprehend fugitives within and about the City of Parkersburg.  6. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert D. Newell to sign the contract for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program from the State of West Virginia in the amount of \$1,350,000.00 to purchase and rehabilitate eight (8) foreclosed and vacant properties and/or vacant and slum and blighted properties in the City's targeted neighborhood; and authorizes the Development Director to submit and sign the financial request forms for this contract. Resolution authorizing an election for the renewal of existing levy under the provisions of WV Code Chapter 11, Article 8, Section 16, to continue the operation of the mass transportation (bus) system.
