  1. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert D. Newell to submit a Community Participation Program grant application in the amount of \$17,500.00 for the skateboard park with a local match of \$1,700.00 coming from funds already raised. (Sponsored by Councilmen Reynolds, Lynch, Joyce, Tallman, and Rockhold.)
  2. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert D. Newell to submit a Community Participation Program grant application in the amount of \$3,000.00 for the skateboard park with a local match of \$300.00 coming from funds already raised. (Sponsored by Councilmen Reed, Lynch, and Rockhold.)

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3. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert D. Newell to submit a Community Participation Program grant application in the amount of \$25,000.00 for the Juleps Pathways project in the City Park with match requirements being met by the Junior League of Parkersburg. (Councilmen Kimes, Tallman, Lynch, Rockhold, Reed, and Reynolds.)

4. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert D. Newell to submit a Community Participation Program grant application in the amount of \$6,000.00 for the Juleps Pathways project in the City Park with match requirements being met by the Junior League of Parkersburg. (Councilmen Kimes, Tallman, Lynch, Rockhold, Reed, and Reynolds.)

5. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert D. Newell to submit a Community Participation Program grant application in the amount of \$6,000.00 for the Homeless with the \$600.00 match being provided by the Parkersburg Area Coalition for the Homeless. (Councilmen Reed, Lynch, Rockhold, and Kimes.)

6. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert D. Newell to submit a Community Participation Program grant application in the amount of \$3,000.00 for the YMCA for renovations to provide child care with the \$300.00 match coming from the YMCA. (Councilman Lynch, Reed, Kimes, and Rockhold.)

7. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert D. Newell to submit a Community Participation Program grant application in the amount of \$10,500.00 for the Boys and Girls Club for new bleachers, painting and new equipment, with the \$1,050.00 match provided by the Boys and Girls Club. (Councilmen Rockhold, Reed, Lynch, and Kimes.)

8. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert D. Newell to submit a Community Participation Program grant application in the amount of \$15,000.00 for Parkersburg Homecoming Festival with the required match by the Homecoming Festival. (Councilman Lynch, Reynolds, Tallman, Kimes, Rockhold, and Reed.)

9. Resolution requesting the Finance Director to request approval from the State Tax Commissioner for a budget revision in the amount of \$25,000.00 moving \$25,000.00 from the sanitation department equipment rental line item, to the finance department equipment rental line item. (sponsored by the Finance Committee)

10. Resolution transferring \$500,000.00 from the unemployment fund to the general fund, and authorizing the Finance Director to make the appropriate budget revisions. (Councilmen Wilcox, Lynch, Kimes, Sandy, Reynolds, Joyce, Rockhold, and Reed.)

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X. ORDINANCE, FIRST READING:

11. An ordinance amending and re-enacting Section 963.01, toll charges, of article 963, Parkersburg Memorial Bridge, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parkersburg. This ordinance increases the base trip rate from 35 cents per trip to 50 cents per trip, and other single unit, 3 axle, 4 axle, 5 axle, and oversize or special vehicles increased as well. It is anticipated that this will generate approximately \$518,000.00 if traffic drops 10%. The funds will be used for major improvements such as painting the bridge, and paving the bridge, or other maintenance as needed. (Sponsored by Councilmen Wilcox, Lynch, Kimes, Sandy, Reynolds, Joyce, Rockhold and Reed.)
