1. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert D. Newell to accept a JAG grant in the amount of \$57,000.00 to fund police officers' salaries and to attend the annual State Pro Conference. \$19,000.00 match required. (Sponsored by Councilmen Rockhold, Sandy, Lynch, Reed, and Kimes.)

2. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert D. Newell to accept a JAG grant in the amount of \$56,250.00 to fund officers' salaries and attend the Task Force Commander School. \$18,750.00 match required. (Sponsored by Councilmen Lynch, Rockhold, Sandy, Reed, and Kimes.)

3. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert D. Newell to execute a contract with Tetrick and Bartlett, PLLC to perform an audit of the City of Parkersburg for fiscal year 2009/2010 for \$25,000.00, as recommended by the Audit Committee. (Sponsored by Councilmen Rockhold, Reed, Kimes, Tallman, Joyce, and Lynch)

4. Resolution adopting the Wood County Hazard Mitigation Plan, and authorizing the Mid Ohio Valley Regional Council to submit it on behalf of participating municipalities in Wood County. (Sponsored by Councilmen Reed, Joyce, and Reynolds.) – (50-page plan available in City Clerk's Office.)

5. Resolution designating two additional targeted neighborhoods to the City's Neighborhood Revitalization Project as follows: Census Tract 7.02 Block Group 1, 7th Street to 13th Street and Plum Street to Market Street; and Census Tract 9.02 Block Group 1, Neal Run to 4th Avenue and WV 95 to Lubeck Avenue. (Sponsored by the URA)

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6. Resolution authorizing an agreement with the Urban Renewal Authority to implement the Neighborhood Stabilization Project. (sponsored by Councilmen Rockhold, Joyce, and Reed.)
