 1. Resolution requesting and urging that the State of West Virginia place a high priority on the upgrading of WV Route 2 to a modern four-lane highway for the Greater Ohio Valley. (Sponsored by Councilmen Chevront, Joyce, Kimes, Myers, and Knapp.)
 2. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert Newell to submit along with the Mid Ohio Valley Planning Council and the Wood County Development Authority, a planning grant to EDA in the amount of \$100,000.00 with a local match of 50%, to identify areas around Corridor D interchanges that could be developed. The City's share of \$25,000.00 will be budgeted from the Capitol Reserve Funds. (Councilmen Reynolds, Kimes, and Joyce.)
 3. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert Newell to sign a 2008 Governor's Community Participation Grant Contract for \$3,000.00 to renovate the former guard building at the Mid Ohio Valley Regional Airport. (Councilmen Reynolds, Myers, Joyce, Knapp, and Tallman.)
 4. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert Newell to sign a 2008 Governor's Community Participation Grant Program Contract for \$2,000.00 to enable the Parkersburg Coalition for the Homeless to purchase furnishings and carpet for the Homeless facility. (Councilmen Tallman, Reynolds, Myers, Joyce, and Knapp.)

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5. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert Newell to execute a contract with the Division of Criminal Justice Services, to receive and administer grant funds pursuant to the JAG program for officer salaries in the amount not to exceed \$56,000.00 to continue a multi-jurisdictional drug and violent crime control task force. (Councilmen Myers, Tallman, Reynolds, Joyce, and Knapp.)
6. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert Newell to execute a contract with the WV Development Office in the amount of \$10,000.00 for Artsbridge to be used for office equipment and marketing material. (Councilmen Knapp, Tallman, Joyce, Kimes, and Myers.)
7. Resolution amending the Rules and Regulations for the Parkersburg Police Department by adding Part E, Executive Officer to rule 4.1.1,II. E. (Councilmen Reynolds, Knapp, and Godfrey)
