- 1. The following bids be accepted:
  - a. Accept bid of \$800 for 924 E. 12<sup>th</sup> Street to be used as a side yard. It is presently being maintained by this property owner.
  - b. Accept bid for \$100 for 505 13 ½ Street to be used as a side yard. It is presently being maintained by this property owner.
  - c. Accept the bid for \$500 for 1047 37<sup>th</sup> Street to be used as a side yard. It is presently being maintained by this property owner. In addition there are no utilities to this property.
  - d. Accept the bid for \$106 for 1118 13<sup>th</sup> Street to be used as a side yard and for parking. It is presently being maintained by this property owner.
