3. Resolution authorizing Mayor Robert Newell to sign an agreement between the City and the WV DOT for \$200,000.00 for Phase III of the Fifth Street Revitalization Project. (Councilmen Kimes, Joyce, Wilcox, Rockhold, Reynolds, Reed, Lynch, and Tallman)

X. ORDINANCE, FINAL READING:

4. An ordinance amending and re-enacting Section 963.01, toll charges, of article 963, Parkersburg Memorial Bridge, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parkersburg. This ordinance increases the base trip rate from 35 cents per trip to 50 cents per trip, and other single unit, 3 axle, 4 axle, 5 axle, and oversize or special vehicles increased as well. It is anticipated that this will generate approximately \$518,000.00 if traffic drops 10%. The funds will be used for major improvements such as painting the bridge, and paving the bridge, or other maintenance as needed.
