There will be a presentation by representatives from the Community ID Division of Buxton Company, a retail site selection firm that works with retailers to pick new store locations.

1. Request from Mayor Robert D. Newell for the Finance Committee to consider a study on three locations in Parkersburg to help develop a sustainable marketing program for retail location in both the long and short term. The study will take approximately 60 days to complete at a cost of \$70,000.00. He is asking City Council to appropriate \$50,000.00 from the Capital Reserve Account towards funding this study.

2. Request from Mayor Robert D. Newell that City Council appropriate \$95,000.00 from the Capital Reserve Account to cover a local match for two grants for the Little Kanawha Connector Trail.

3. Request from Finance Director, Doug Life, to authorize a budget revision in the amount of \$8,190.00 as miscellaneous revenue from a demolition.

4. Request from the Finance Director to move \$10,000.00 from the street department to the building and grounds department to cover unexpected costs.

5. Request from the Finance Director to transfer \$5,500.00 from the street department to the central garage to purchase a motor.

6. Request from the Finance Director to authorize a budget revision in the amount of \$148,700.00 from a grant for the new boiler and water heaters in the City Building.

7. Request from the Finance Director to authorize a budget revision in the amount of \$36,199.00 from a JAG grant for the police department In-Synch System.

8. Request from the Finance Director to authorize a budget revision in the amount of \$3,000.00 from a grant for the Veteran's Museum.
